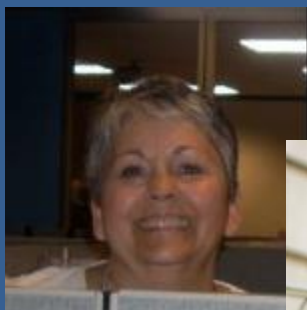




April 1, 2016 Meeting
