## Proudly We Hail Recognition

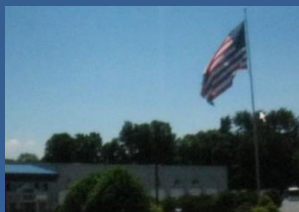
The club presented three Proudly We Hail Awards for commendable display of the US Flag. The award recognizes businesses and individuals for their honor and respect for the US Flag.

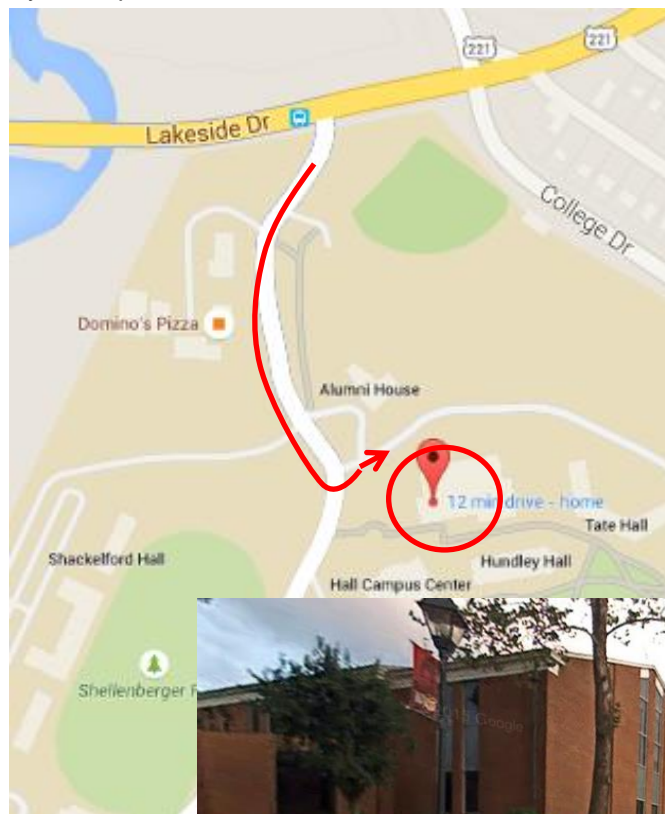
**President’s Dinner – June 19**
