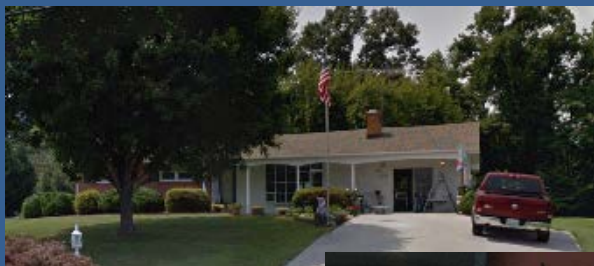




Proudly We Hail Award Presentation
